Message from the Trustee of the Combined Nuclear Pension Plan to our members re Covid-19 Coronavirus

Whilst all sensible measures are being taken to mitigate the impact of the virus and keep services running as normal, the Trustee has had to consider plans if the situation worsens. The Trustee has decided that payment of pensions must be the top priority. This means that if services are affected, the Trustee and both the DB and DC Plan administrators will be prioritising pension payments to the forefront of what we protect. Coronavirus is affecting us all and requires us all to pull together to get through this.
