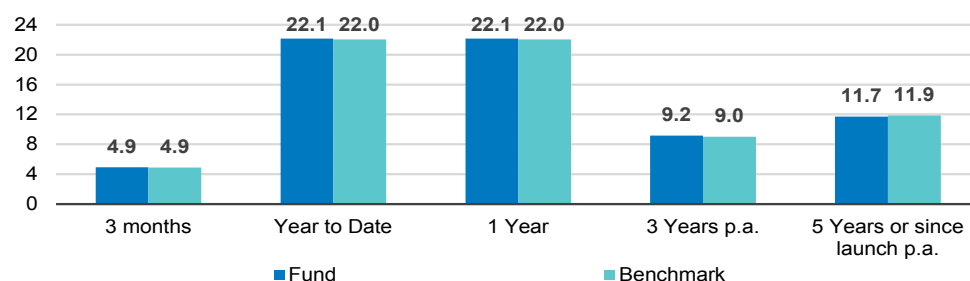
Fund objective

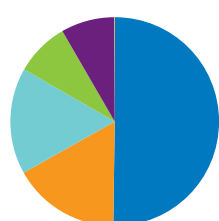

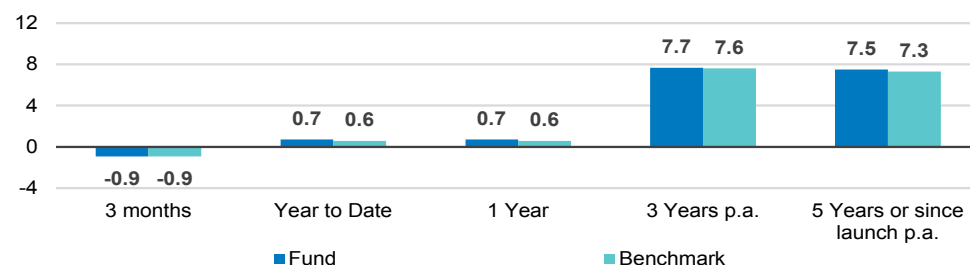

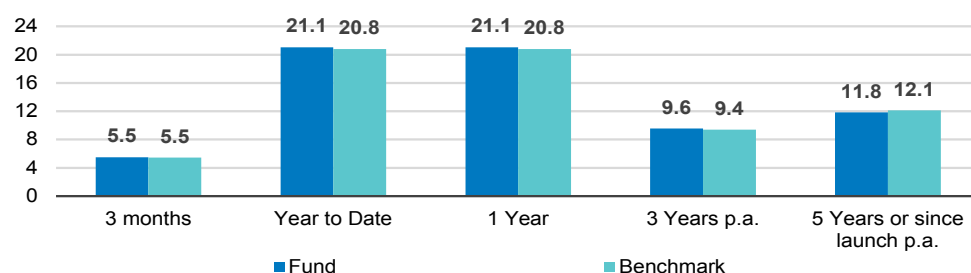

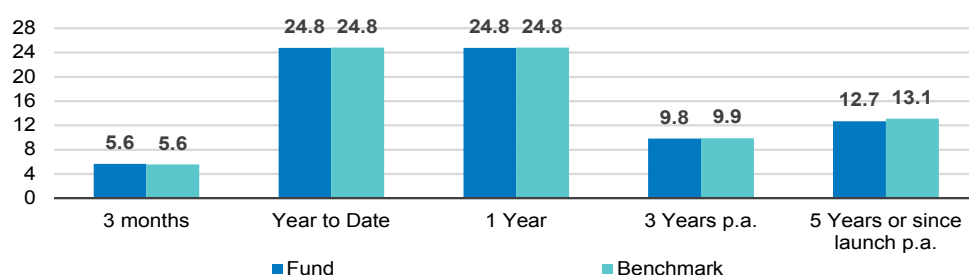

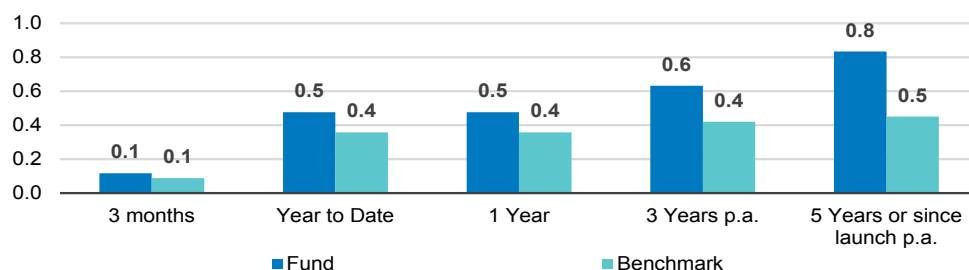

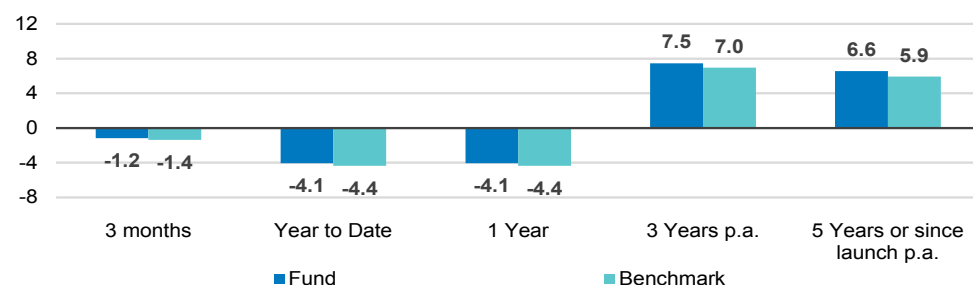

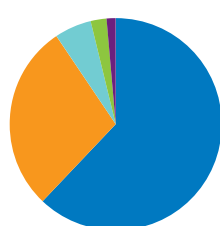

DC Pre-Retirement

The value of your plan depends directly on a number of things, including the level of your pensions savings, charges, investment returns and the annuity rates available to buy your pension income when you decide to take your benefits. Typically, when interest rates rise, there is a corresponding decline in the market value of bonds. Credit risk refers to the possibility that the issuer of the bond will not be able to repay the principal and make interest payments.
